Dundurn Rural Water Utility—2019/2020 Annual General Meeting

Dundurn Rural Water Utility will be holding their 2019/2020 Annual General Meeting (AGM) on:

Wednesday, January 26, 2022 at the Dundurn Community Hall starting at 7:00 p.m.

There are two **(2) vacant positions** available for directors. One from District #1 and one from District #2.

District #1 is the R.M. of Corman Park and the R.M. of Blucher.

District #2 is the R.M. of Dundurn, the Town of Dundurn, the Resort Village of Shields and the Resort Village of Thode.

Every Board director must be a subscriber or a municipal designate.

A water user who is nominated as a candidate must file a nomination paper in the prescribed form as per the Local Government Elections Act (Saskatchewan) Part VIII Elections in Rural Municipalities. The nomination paper **must be submitted** to the Dundurn Rural Water Utility administrator during normal office hours **at least 14 days prior to the Annual Meeting** (Wednesday, January 12, 2022 at 4:00 p.m.)

No nominations will be accepted at the Annual Meeting.

Voyent! is a Canadian company which allows the Utility to email, call or text any emergency notices. Please ensure you respond to the notifications sent to you. Please call the office if you want to change your method of notification.

DID YOU KNOW...

- * We keep our website updated (be sure to check during water related emergencies). Check for all other current information. Our web-site is: www.dundurnruralwater.ca
- * We now process monthly water bills - if you would like to change from quarterly billing to monthly please call the office . But remember - to receive a monthly bill you must receive your bill by email (eNotice).
- * If you get a talk mail or email about a water related emergency it AFFECTS you - if you haven't heard from us it means it DOES NOT affect you.
- * If you don't give us your address change, email address change, or change of phone number we will not be able to contact you. Please ensure you keep the Utility up to date.
- * If your meter is squealing - you do NOT have to put up with that - call the office and our maintenance staff will fix that!
- * We continue to upgrade our meter reading system. Each year we add more Badger endpoints which will allow subscribers to monitor their own water consumption and allows the Utility to read these meters from the office.
- * Please notify our office if you sell your property as a final read of your meter will need to be completed. Please provide our office with the new owners name and telephone number.

Dundurn Rural Water Utility—2021 Annual Update

As 2021 comes to a close, we look back on the growth of Dundurn Rural Water. In the past year construction was completed on a new subdivision with 16 new curbstops. We installed curb stops to 6 new subscribers. We continue to get many inquiries on new water connections. As of December 18th, we have installed 22 new subscriber curb stops. We have installed 24 water meters to curbstop customers.

We will be starting off the new year with 2,221 total subscribers. We estimate our end users including the residents of the Towns of Dundurn and Hanley, the Resort Villages of Shields and Thode and Riverside Estates to be 4016 water users (Sept 2021).

We are proud of our Utility and look forward to 2021.
