### WATER FILL STATION

Our water fill station at Pump House #2, along Highway 11 and Tamke Road, is now complete! A FOB is required to use this station. The agreement can be found on our website, or can be filled out at the office. This is a prepaid system. After every use you will receive an email stating how much water you took and the amount left on your account. We ask that if you notice your amount remaining is getting low to please call the office during business hours: Monday - Friday 8:00a.m. - 4:00 p.m. to add more money to your account.


Costs:

FOB - \$35.00

Water - \$27.00/1000 gallons

Annual Fee - \$25.00

### DO YOU HAVE A RENTER?

Our policy states that if you have a renter, you must receive your water bill monthly by email and the water bill will stay in the property owner's name. However, we still require the name and all contact information for the renter so they can be notified should there be a water related emergency.

**WATER QUALITY OF WATER DELIVERED TO OUR SUBSCRIBERS**

As you are aware, the Dundurn Rural Water Utility buys its water from SaskWater who purchases the water from the City of Saskatoon. Each of our pump houses pump the water through closed pipelines. Once you have clicked on Saskatoon Waterworks, you can choose any parameter to view the Minimum Allowable Limit or the Maximum Allowable Limit. For example, if you choose Total Dissolved Solids (TDS), you will see the provincial limit is 1500 mg/L. The City's TDS is 289 mg/L. Total Dissolved Solids represents the total concentration of dissolved substances in the water. An easy way to say this is anything and everything that can be in the water.

**The Dundurn Rural Water Utility is recommending that you clean out your water tank once per year if possible.**
